The Tournament Directors reviewed the pictures from the Angler after the protest was filed. This picture was accepted based on consistency with all of the Anglers photos. The "H" in "HGF" was fading. But I can see half of the "H" and the "GF" are clearly visible.

Please reach out to me anytime there are issues. I am merely a gatekeeper for the club. We have a Board of Directors (Officers) that I can bring any and all issues to. As far as the tournaments go, the Tournament Directors are there to develop and enforce the rules. When there are problems, they are promptly presented to the Officers so that no one person makes a ruling.

We need the pic of the trout that he is saying he photographed when his phone crapped out. The original pic with metadata. It is possible to edit the metadata on a computer before a photo is submitted to accepting it at this point could be sketchy if he's that smart or tries

The redfish, we need to discuss if we should consider accepting it. If the answer is yes then I think he needs to provide a photo of that fish with metadata. Otherwise he would have broken another rule with that fish photo and it should be DQ'd.
